East Row Footbridge



Overview

East Row Beck is on the North East Coast, approximately 5km north of Whitby.

The contract to design and supply a new FRP footbridge placed 10m downstream of East Row Road Bridge was completed by Lifespan Structures. The area is designated as a Conservation Area, and the care had to be taken to match the aesthetics of the new bridge to the surrounding areas.

The new FRP bridge deck was 16.7m long and 3m wide with an aluminium parapet attached to the outside edge to match existing hand railings used along the walls for the Beck. The use of an FRP bridge was particularly suitable due to the exposed marine environment and the fast easy installation reducing disruption to the area.
